Resort Village Elections, 2012

Next year is an election year for the Resort Village of Glen Harbour. This election will be for the position of one Mayor and two Council members. The two current Council Members have indicated they will not seek re-election.

Elected officials serve for a term of four years and are involved in decisions affecting the day to day affairs of the Resort Village.

If you are interested in this process you should think about putting your name forward in the next election.

Flood Protection

The Council of the Resort Village of Glen Harbour is attempting to engage the services of an engineering firm in order to identify flood protection solutions. More information will be made available once the assessment is complete.

Information Request

The Resort Village of Glen Harbour has now automated its record keeping systems and much greater use of electronic technology will be occurring in the future. Accessory Buildings

In response to inquiries received pertaining to the construction of accessory buildings:

Only one carport or private garage or boathouse is allowed per lot;

I Maximum height is 20 feet; and

Effective immediately the maximum size approved will be as stipulated in the existing bylaw, 900 square feet.

Contact the Resort Village Administrator for the necessary permit applications and Zoning Bylaw requirement details.

Defibrillator

A defibrillator has been purchased by the Resort Village of Glen Harbour. This equipment will be located at the Sebastian residence at 140 Bluebird Drive. If the Sebastian's are unavailable, this equipment will be located at the Righetti residence at 60 Kingbird Drive. If you are trained in the use of this equipment or if you are interested in obtaining the training and operating the defibrillator equipment in case of an emergency, please contact Michele.

An Eppy pen for use in the event insect sting reactions is also available at 140 Bluebird Drive.

Rodent Issues

Recently there have been reports of rats and other rodents being sighted at the Resort Village. A Pest Control Officer has been contacted and has investigated the area, with no infestation identified.

Your assistance is needed to ensure that these rodents do not become permanent. Please ensure that all garbage is properly secured and that all piles of debris and other areas that might attract rodents are completely tidied up. Your attention to keeping our Resort Village rodent-free is great appreciated.
