Resort Village of Glen Harbour Bonfires and Open Air Fire Policy 2019

The Resort Village of Glen Harbour has limited fire protection. You are responsible for all damages or nuisance caused by fire or smoke to your own property as well as neighboring property. A policy has been developed for responsible bonfires and open fires as:

- 1. The fire must be contained in a non-combustible receptacle made of cement, brick, clay or sheet metal with a minimum 18 gauge thickness.
- 2. The fire pit must be located a safe distance from any combustible material.
- 3. Fires must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- 4. Any person who uses a fire pit shall have a means of extinguishing the fire readily accessible at all times.
- 5. Fires must be extinguished if smoke causes an unreasonable interference with the use and enjoyment of another person's property.
- 6. Fire pits shall not be used in windy or dry conditions.
- 7. In the event the Council issues a Fire Ban, the use of fire pits will be prohibited.
- 8. No open fires will be permitted on public property. Only by permission of Council, the fire pit located at the Community Centre may be used.
