BYLAW NO 67/2023

A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

The Council of the Resort Village of Glen Harbour in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a) "Council" means the Council of the Resort Village of Glen Harbour;
 - b) "Municipality" means the Resort Village of Glen Harbour; and
 - c) "Party" means either the Council or the Bylaw Enforcement Officer.
- 2. Council hereby appoints Rocky Coleman as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Municipality.
- 3. The appointment shall commence on approval of this bylaw and shall continue indefinitely in accordance with the agreement identified as Schedule "A".
- 4. The appointment may be terminated by either party providing written notice to the other party at least 30 days prior to the termination becoming effective.
- 5. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
 - a) To enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the council of the Municipality;
 - b) To represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw; and
 - c) Other duties as may be assigned by Council or its delegate.
- 6. Bylaw #05/2017 is hereby repealed.

This bylaw shall come into effect on the day of its final passing.
