Council meeting dates will be posted on the Resort Village's website and on the bulletin board as you enter the Village. If you wish to attend a meeting to bring a matter to Council's attention, please contact the Administrator at least 10 days prior to a scheduled meeting in order to arrange a time for you to address Council. Please also note that all ratepayers are welcome to attend any of the regularly scheduled Council meetings in an observation capacity only. Anyone attending these meetings is required to sit quietly and observe the deliberations of Council.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

1. A resident survey is being prepared. It is important that everyone has in-put into what is happening in the Village. Please complete and return the survey that will be sent to every resident.
2. Fire Ban notices will be put on the bulletin board and the website as required. Before lighting a fire out of doors, please check if there is a fire ban.
3. The regular Lorass bins for garbage and recycling will remain located near the Community Center. Please respect our beach and make sure all the garbage is placed in a bin.
4. The pier and both boat launches have been installed and are operational. Bumpers for the new dock have also been installed.
5. New by-laws
 - i. Strasbourg "False Alarm Bylaw" No. 387/18 was enacted on July 11, 2018, stating that "where a false alarm is activated, the organization or individual having control shall pay a response fee to the Town of Strasbourg"; first false alarm, warning but no fee, subsequent false alarms within a 12 month period are \$500.00 each.
 - ii. Building Bylaw No. 51 – 2019 is in the process of being approved by Building Standards. Check the website for details.
6. Culvert cleanout: Last fall the village began the process of cleaning out all the culverts and drainage ditches; and opening up all closed catch basins. The clean-up continued this spring and is now complete.
7. Do you know someone who has just moved here, or has changed their e-mail address? Please let them know that it's important to let the Village office know.
