
A BYLAW TO REGULATE AND PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS

The Council of the Resort Village of Glen Harbour in the  
Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Subject to section 3, no person shall discharge any gun or other firearms, air-gun, or spring gun or any class or type thereof within the municipality of the Resort Village of Glen Harbour.
2. The provisions of section 1 do not apply to a person who is:
  - a) a peace officer
  - b) a responsible person approved by council to discharge a firearm to rid the municipality of the Resort Village of Glen Harbour of rabid animals, vermin, and/or pests (rats/skunks).
3. A person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction shall be liable to a maximum fine of \$2000.00 (two thousand) payable to the clerk within a stated period of time and that, on payment as so provided, that person is not liable to persecution for the offence.


